Course Description:

This course continues the study of composition and formal processes in drawing and painting. This is a skill building class. The curriculum is strictly confined to increasing skills to the maximum level. This skill base will empower the student to be able to express them selves as individual artists without being limited by the process or media. This class curriculum is based on the Florida Sunshine State Standards, grades 9-12 and AP studio Art standards. This is a portfolio building class. Students will produce a wide variety of works designed to show their maximum potential and range.

Homework Policy

Students will have a sketchbook assignment due once a week, on either Wednesday or Thursday. The assignment will be graded in class along with a one on one discussion about the assignment and how they are progressing.

Make-up work

Sketchbook-Each 9 weeks the students are allotted 3 grace periods. They can turn in their sketchbook the following week for a reduced grade. Work will not be accepted as late once the 3 grace periods have been used.

Students can also makeup work after school on Tuesdays or Thursdays from 3:10-5:00pm.

Required materials

Students will be required to have their own paint kits and a 9x12 sketchbook. The kit can be purchased at Reddi-Arts on Hendricks Ave. The kit includes 'Basics' paint, brushes, glazing medium, palette paper and a sketch book. The cost is around \$100.00
